WishStar Programme effect on students

Throughout our lives we connect and interact with people. Empathy is the essence of human relationships. It helps us to recognize not only what we see, but also what we don't see, the feelings and thoughts behind actions. Empathy is the ability to understand what others are feeling, to be able to see things from their perspective and to imagine ourselves in another's place. In short to be able to put ourselves in another's shoes, to feel what they are feeling. This is an important life skill, particularly for children, as it is essential that they understand from an early age that their actions can affect the people around them.

Awareness and psychosocial preparation will lead students to the acceptance of serious illness, since it is by sharing the appropriate knowledge that we lay the foundation for the cultivation of empathy.

Through this process the children are able:

- to trust adults:
- to manage and express their feelings;
- to feel comfortable enough to ask questions;
- to help in their own way.

Children are not young adults and their understanding depends on their developmental stage. It is important to explain the concept of empathy to students and help them put themselves in the shoes of Make-A-Wish children.

It is also necessary for them to understand the difference between a serious illness and a simple illness, e.g. a cold, that a serious illness is not contagious and that they should not avoid a classmate if they get sick or if they look different. The school community should be an emotional refuge for all children where they feel equal and express themselves freely.

In this context, the children of Make-A-Wish will be able to have some sense of childhood and carefreeness restored back into them. The WishStar will light the way for every sick child to become a child again.

- ★ The school is a miniature of our society. Therefore, on the occasion of the WishStar, we raise awareness among children of all ages in order to help them develop empathy. We form citizens that care for their fellow human beings, with a strong sense of equality and acceptance.
- ★ The WishStar becomes the messenger of love, friendship and acceptance. A messenger with a bag full of wishes to awaken the child within, guided by the children as our compass and destination. By doing so, we all become better human beings, because having full awareness of another's situation, we are also fully aware of our own diversity and our own selves.



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Implementation process



Inform students & parents through the information material (free of charge) by contacting schools@makeawish.gr or 210 963 7667.



In collaboration with your students, decide on the desired number of stars you would like to purchase.



Place your order online or by phone. Visit www.wishstar.gr and click Online Order Schools. Fill in the necessary details in the online order form.



By placing the order online, you have the option of choosing which wish you would like to contribute to.



The WishStar team prepares your order immediately, making sure you receive it within 7 days free of charge (contains stars - fabric wristbands - information material).



Once you have completed the action, make the deposit of your donation according to the instructions in the package you receive with the stars.



Upon completion of the programme, you will receive your wish adoption certificate and receipt of your donation electronically. **Keep your proof of payment until we send you the receipt of your donation.**
